Special Notes for all Foreign Language Majors:

- At least 40 of the total 120 hours required for graduation must be in 300-400-level courses.
- No course in which a C- or lower grade is earned will be counted toward the major; pass/fail courses do not count either.
- No course may be repeated for credit toward the major or count for the major and minor.
- Of the 34 hours required for the major, at least 15 must be taken in residence at WSU. These 15 credits may not be earned using advanced placement or challenge exam credit. Six (6) of these 15 hours must be at the 400-level.
- Credits for 105, 205, and 305 may not be applied toward the major.
- A maximum of 12 credits per semester OR 18 credits per year may be transferred from study abroad.
- NOTE: a **2nd major** in French requires completion of major requirements only; a **2nd degree** requires completion of extra CLA GER requirements, a total of 150 overall university credits, payment of degree application fee. Visit with your advisor for assistance.
